# Important Competition Information

## Competition winners criteria

Competition entries will be judged during the week commencing 16 June by a panel of local community members. The judges will review all art work submitted for the competition and a winner and runner up will be selected for each section, which may meet the following criteria:-

- > Demonstration of re-use or recycling of material
- > Waste reduction message
- > Artistic quality
- > Craftsmanship and quality of artwork
- > Aesthetic merit & creativity
- > Each entry must be no larger than 1m<sup>2</sup> x 1.5m high;
- > Each entry must address one of the following principles - Avoid, Reduce, Reuse, Recycle;

The results of the competition will be announced in the local media. Winners will be advised either on the night of the exhibition launch, phone or mail.

## Entry submissions procedure

1. Entry forms are to be completed & returned to Gunnedah Shire Council Creative Arts Gallery by 13<sup>th</sup> June 2008 – 2 copies attached to the artwork.
2. Artworks are to be delivered to the Creative Arts Gallery by 13 June 2008.
3. Entries will be judged week commencing 16 June, with an exhibition launch to be held on 20 June – where winners will be announced.

## Conditions of Entry

- > Waste>Art & Design is open to all community members, artists and schools who are current residents of the Gunnedah Shire Council area.
- > Entrants may only submit one artwork in each category.
- > In the Regional Competition, entrants in the Schools Sections 1 & 2 will win prizes on behalf of their School.
- > All artworks must demonstrate the re-use or recycling of waste.
- > When completing this entry form, entrants agree that their artwork may be photographed, used in promotional material and displays in any public exhibition held by the organisers.
- > The organisers will take reasonable care in dealing with any materials submitted however, they will not accept responsibility for loss or damage which may occur.
- > All artworks will remain the property of the artist and must be collected at the end of the exhibition period.
