conditions of entry

- Entrants must reside in one of the participating Council areas
- Entrants may only submit one entry in each category
- The entry must be the original work of the artist
- The item can not have been previously entered in the competition
- In the Regional Competition, entrants in the School sections will win prizes on behalf of their school
- All artworks must incorporate the re-use or recycling of waste pre/loved materials
- Each entry must be no larger than 1m² x 1.5m² and should be of a weight that can be reasonably handled by one person
- All artworks must be clearly labeled with the entrant's name and artwork name upon delivery to Council
- Any wall hangings must come complete with a hanging mechanism
- The organizers will take reasonable care in dealing with the entries submitted, but will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage that may occur
- All artworks remain the property of the entrant and must be collected after the exhibition
- Competition coordinators reserve the right to amend the entry category specified by the entrant if it is deemed to be incorrect
