

Aerosol Cans

Over 10 billion aerosols are produced worldwide annually - proof of their popularity, convenience and value for money. Here in Australia, we purchase over 200 million aerosols every year - over 10 for every man, woman and child.

Steel is the world's most recycled material and over 70 percent of Australian aerosols are made of it.

This means that every steel (tinplate) aerosol contains recycled content and with your support the steel in it can be recycled again and again, saving energy and resources.

Over 14.5 million Australians are able to recycle their empty steel aerosols, thanks to their local council, the Steel Can Recycling Council & BlueScope Steel.

Remember to ensure that your aerosol is empty and do not pierce or squash the aerosol. If possible remove plastic parts that come off easily such as the lids.
